2023 Youth Tour — 57th Year

Some of the highlights of the trip:

- **1,900 representatives** from electric cooperatives all across the nation will be in D.C., including about 40 youth from Minnesota electric cooperatives. Meet with your Members of Congress and make new lifelong friends
- **Tour the monuments:** Washington Monument, Lincoln Memorial, Jefferson Memorial, Franklin Delano Roosevelt Memorial, Vietnam Veterans Memorial, Korean Veterans Memorial, World War II Memorial, Arlington Cemetery, Air Force Memorial and Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial.
- **Tour historic sites:** Smithsonian Museums, Holocaust Museum, Mount Vernon, National Cathedral, Newseum and 9/11 Memorial.
- Attend special events: Visit your Congressional leaders, theater performance and allstate dance.
- **Go places:** Apply to be the Minnesota representative on the Youth Leadership Council. If selected, you will travel back to D.C. in July 2023 for a youth leadership conference and also attend the National Rural Electric Convention in San Antonio, Texas from February 29-March 6, 2024.
